Course Description

Building on the foundation of Observational Drawing I, this course deepens your perceptual drawing skills through more complex subjects and expanded methodologies. You'll explore both traditional approaches—such as comparative measurement, perspective refinement, and tonal rendering—and non-traditional strategies that introduce a broader range of mark-making, gesture, and interpretation. Subjects include dynamic still life, interior space, and natural forms, with an emphasis on developing sensitivity to structure, light, and spatial relationships. This course encourages a more personal and expressive response to observational work while reinforcing precision and discipline. Ideal for students who want to strengthen their visual logic, broaden their toolbox, and begin bridging the gap between observation and interpretation.
