Introduction to Etching is a 4-week course allowing students to have a basic understanding of the copper plate etching process. This course will cover plate preparation, hardground line etching, aquatint, and the printing process. While enrolled in Introduction to Etching, participants may attend open print studio hours outside of instruction hours for no additional cost for the duration of the 4-week introductory course.
